**numerator**

The number above the fraction bar in a fraction.

**fraction**

A symbol, such as  $\frac{2}{3}$ ,  $\frac{5}{1}$ , or  $\frac{8}{5}$ , used to describe one or more parts of a whole that is divided into equal parts.

**mixed number**

A number that has a whole-number part and a fractional part.

**denominator**

The number below the fraction bar in a fraction.

**common factor**

A number that is a factor of two or more given numbers.

**improper fraction**

A fraction whose numerator is greater than or equal to its denominator.

**simplest form**

A fraction in which the greatest common factor of the numerator and denominator is 1.

**greatest common factor (GCF)**

The greatest number that is a factor of two or more given numbers.

**benchmark fraction**

Common fractions used for estimating, such as  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{2}{3}$ , and  $\frac{3}{4}$ .
